Free Parking Offer

From Monday 6 - Friday 24 December, parking in all City Council car parks in the City Centre will be 'free after 3' Monday to Saturday and free all day on Sunday 12 and Sunday 19 December.

Crowngate Shopping Centre

Overnight parking £1 (17:00-21:00hrs) Sundays and Bank Holidays £1; Open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

- First bus from County Hall leaves at 08:35hrs then 08:50hrs, 09:05hrs, 09:20hrs then every 10 minutes
- Last bus back from Crowngate Bus Station is 20:10hrs or from Cathedral Square at 20:15hrs.

Sunday 5 December

- First bus from County Hall leaves at 09:45hrs then every 15 minutes
- Last bus back from Crowngate Bus Station is 17:10hrs or from Cathedral Square at 17:15hrs.

Prices

- Adult Return £3.00
- Group ticket £7.00 travelling together (driver and up to six passengers)
- £1 for Children 5–16 years
- Children under five years travel for free

NB: County Hall Park and Ride may be used by un-booked coaches that are not willing to pay the fly coach charge on Saturday or Sunday. Passengers must not be dropped off within the City Centre, but take the P&R bus (chargeable) from/to County Hall.

GIN LAN CLIK CLIK COLLECTIVE

Return to a time when the alley dwellers inhabited the streets; a time of pickpockets, magic music halls and many unsavoury sorts! Welcome to the dark and playful world of 'Gin Lane': a Victorian alleyway with its debauched inhabitants, cast out of society and looking to make a quick sixpence or two!

Returning home to their now plague free and fumigated alley dwelling, the inhabitants are back for a 6th slice of mischief bringing an immersive and cheeky installation with shady characters, performances and sing-songs to provide an alternative Victorian experience.

Make your way down the Shambles and look for this precarious alleyway to hang out amongst the hawkers and flower sellers, magic and alchemy, urchins, gin addiction, singing and dancing.

Gin Lane produced by Clik Clik Collective combines the talents of local artists and performers. Come sing along with 'Play It Again Dan' (Dan Bramhall) tinkling the ivories to bring the old Music halls back to life while 'Lee's Fleas' will keep you entertained. And watch those pockets as the urchins from Worcester Theatre Makers are prowling.

Clik Clik is a Worcester based producer, creating unique immersive installations and pop up experiences, through both solo work and by bringing together a diverse range of freelance artists and performers.
